Dear Anti-Hemophilia Provider,

Subject: Resubmission of Claims

EDS, an HP company, has discovered a system error that resulted in the erroneous denial of claims for HCPCS codes J7197 and J7198 with the following Remittance Advice Details (RAD) reason codes:

- **0145:** This procedure is not a Medi-Cal benefit on this date of service.
- **0225:** This is an incorrect procedure code and/or modifier for this service. Please resubmit.
- **0009:** This service or NDC (National Drug Code) is not a covered benefit of the program.

This error affected claims with dates of service January 1, 2006 through January 27, 2008, but processed between January 28, 2008 and December 2, 2008.

No action is required on your part. EDS has resubmitted the affected claims. In addition to this issue, some other claims have been found which were denied for one of the RAD codes above and would not be denied now for these reasons. All these resubmits will be paid, or denied for a valid reason, on RADs beginning April 16, 2009, with Claim Control Number (CCN) prefix **908655**.

If you disagree with any of these resubmits, you may submit a *Claims Inquiry Form* (CIF) within six months of the new RAD date. For CIF completion instructions, please refer to the *CIF Completion* and *CIF Special Billing Instructions* sections in the appropriate Part 2 manual or on the Medi-Cal Web site ([www.medi-cal.ca.gov](http://www.medi-cal.ca.gov)).
