Important NPI Time Frame Changes

The California Department of Health Services (CDHS) has been advised by its Medi-Cal Fiscal Intermediary (F.I.), EDS, that more time is needed to implement and test system changes to ensure correct and timely payment of claims submitted

with a National Provider Identifier (NPI). Ensuring timely and accurate payment to Medi-Cal providers is of the utmost priority.

Medi-Cal Provider Number and NPI Dual-Use Period – May 23, 2007 to November 25, 2007

To maintain payment accuracy and timely payment to Medi-Cal providers, CDHS will not be implementing all NPI system changes on May 23, 2007. Instead, CDHS is taking a preliminary step toward NPI compliance, with what Medi-Cal is referring to as a “dual-use” period. This will mitigate risk to claims payment integrity and permit providers to use their NPI on specified claim transactions and receive an NPI (in addition to their Medi-Cal provider number) on claim payment responses via the electronic ANSI ASC X12N 835 transaction and the *Remittance Advice Details* (RAD). This dual-use period begins May 23, 2007.

The dual-use period encourages submission of an NPI along with the Medi-Cal provider number. Use of the Medi-Cal provider number is mandatory. Claims submitted without a Medi-Cal provider number prior to November 26, 2007 will not be accepted for processing. Please note that some exceptions apply where only the Medi-Cal provider number can be received during the dual-use period.

- Electronic pharmacy claims (NCPDP 5.1/1.1 standard)
- All proprietary Medi-Cal forms, including the *Payment Request for Long Term Care* form (25-1), *Pharmacy Claim Form* (30-1), *Compound Drug Pharmacy Claim Form* (30-4), *Treatment Authorization Request* (TAR), *Claims Inquiry Form* (CIF) and *Appeal Form* (90-1)
- Direct Data Entry (DDE) applications, including Internet Professional Claim Submission (IPCS), Real-Time Internet Pharmacy (RTIP) and the Point of Service (POS) Network

Further information regarding additional exceptions, as well as technical details about dual-use submission, will be available in the “NPI” area of the Medi-Cal Web site (www.medi-cal.ca.gov).

Claims submitted with only an NPI between May 23, 2007 and November 25, 2007 will not be processed (for crossover claims, see “Medicare Crossover Claims”). CDHS plans to implement NPI system changes allowing only an NPI on November 26, 2007. If only a Medi-Cal provider number is submitted after November 25, 2007, the claim will not be accepted for processing.

Using an NPI and a Medi-Cal provider number during the dual-use period will promote a more successful implementation of NPI. CDHS encourages Medi-Cal providers to migrate away from using a Medi-Cal provider number in their business systems during this time when Medi-Cal provides both sets of identifiers on the ANSI ASC X12N 835 transaction and the paper RAD.

NPI Time Frame *(continued)*

This dual-use period will be a good time for providers to evaluate their business processes and potential needs to request subpart NPI numbers for accounting systems. CDHS recommends that all providers evaluate their subpart determinations during this period and make appropriate updates with Medi-Cal should there be a need for more NPI subparts, or a reduction in the number of subparts currently registered with Medi-Cal. Subpart determination is based on provider choice and should be based on a provider's business needs.

Register an NPI with Medi-Cal

As a result of this dual-use period, CDHS is extending the deadline for providers to register their NPI through the National Provider Identifier Collection (NPIC) online system from March 1, 2007 to May 23, 2007. To access the NPIC online system, click the "NPI" link on the Medi-Cal Web site home page (www.medi-cal.ca.gov) and click "Register, Update and Inquire About NPIs." It is important that Medi-Cal providers register their NPI as soon as possible to ensure adequate time for its incorporation into the Medi-Cal payment system. After registering an NPI, the next steps toward successful NPI implementation are for providers to use an NPI in conjunction with their Medi-Cal provider number and evaluate the impact of their subpart determinations.

Medicare Crossover Claims

Currently, Medi-Cal receives electronic crossover files from the Medicare Coordination of Benefits Contractor (COBC), Group Health Incorporated (GHI), for dual-eligible recipients. These electronic crossovers, commonly referred to as "automatic crossover claims," are transmitted by the COBC and processed by Medi-Cal without provider intervention. Current automatic crossover processing and payment to the correct Medi-Cal provider number depends on the Medicare legacy provider number included on the claim. Similarly, automatic crossover processing on or after May 23, 2007 will depend on the NPI and provider registration of that NPI with Medi-Cal. Only automatic crossover claims containing an NPI registered with Medi-Cal will be processed. Any automatic crossover claims sent to Medi-Cal containing an NPI not registered with Medi-Cal will be rejected as unidentifiable and will not be processed.

Future NPI Instructions

Additional dual-use information about claim forms and electronic transactions that will support dual-use will be published in future *Medi-Cal Updates*. Information about completing electronic claims, including which fields and segments to use (Medi-Cal Companion Guides), will also be released soon.

CDHS encourages all providers to refer to future announcements and to visit the Medi-Cal Web site (www.medi-cal.ca.gov) for updates. Click the "NPI" link for the latest and most up-to-date information about the NPI dual-use, implementation and claim form transition.

**Revised Application Form Requirements, Procedures Due to NPI Implementation**

Effective May 23, 2007, applicants and providers will be required to submit their National Provider Identifier (NPI) with each Medi-Cal provider application package. Current Medi-Cal providers will be required to submit both the NPI and any Medi-Cal provider numbers issued previously on any application forms submitted to the California Department of Health Services (CDHS).

In accordance with Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) requirements, CDHS is revising all provider enrollment application forms to accommodate the NPI. Implementation of the NPI by May 23, 2007 is a requirement of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA). Information in this article is effective May 23, 2007, and published based on the authority granted by *Welfare and Institutions Code* (W&I Code), Section 14043.75(b).

Note: This article is published while CDHS considers how to further implement CMS HIPAA requirements. CDHS may address additional changes through future *Medi-Cal Updates*.

In addition to revisions made to implement the NPI, a section was added to the provider agreement, incorporating Section 6032 of the federal Deficit Reduction Act of 2005. These requirements were published in the December 2006 *Medi-Cal Update* and were effective January 1, 2007.

Revised Application Form *(continued)***Procedures and Requirements**

Applicants must submit their NPI with the appropriate revised application forms listed below to enroll as a Medi-Cal provider. If providers are not eligible to receive an NPI, they are not required to submit an NPI and should instead enter the word “atypical” in the NPI field. These “atypical providers” receive a unique Medi-Cal provider number once the application is approved.

Applicants with more than one NPI must submit the additional NPIs registered with Medicare or other carriers to ensure proper payment of crossover claims.

The revised forms listed below are required for all application and disclosure packages received by CDHS on or after May 23, 2007. Application and disclosure packages received before May 23, 2007 are processed under the rules and regulations in effect at the time of receipt. The NPI, if available, should be written on those forms. CDHS provider enrollment staff will contact applicants to obtain verification of the NPI numbers.

Valid NPI Verification

Applicants must submit verification of each NPI submitted to CDHS in an application package, including the *Medi-Cal Supplemental Changes* form, if appropriate. Applicants are required to attach a copy of the CMS/National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) confirmation letter for each NPI listed in the application package. CDHS will not process an application package without the valid NPI verification.

Taxonomy Codes

Each applicant must submit all taxonomy codes provided in their original application to CMS/NPPES.



NPI News from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services

Reminder to Supply Legacy Identifiers on an NPI Application

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) urges providers to include legacy identifiers (this includes the Medi-Cal provider number) and associated provider identifier type(s) on their NPI applications. This will help all health plans, including Medicare, to prepare for May 23, 2007. Providers who have already applied for an NPI, but did not include identifiers, must go into the National Plan and Provider Enumeration System (NPPES) and update their legacy identifier(s) information. Providers must ensure that the legacy identifiers are those used to bill for services and that NPPES is updated with this information for all health plans. This information is critical for health plans and health care clearinghouses to develop crosswalks to aid in the NPI transition.

Also, Adjustment Reason Codes (ARC), Health Care Remarks Codes (HCRC) and code descriptions have been revised in the *Remittance Advice Details (RAD) Electronic Correlation Table to National Codes* section in the Part 1 manual.

Among the updates, extensive description changes have been made to ARC 16, 17, 96 and 125. In addition, three new ARC (197, 198 and 199) were added, along with six new HCRC (N373, N374, N375, N377, N378 and N379).

Deactivated codes, including ARC 62 (deactivation effective April 1, 2007) and D21 (deactivation effective February 1, 2007), have been removed from the manual replacement pages.

Medi-Cal Suspended and Ineligible Provider List: March Update

Medi-Cal Suspended and Ineligible Provider List and Office of Inspector General List of Excluded Individuals

The *Medi-Cal Suspended and Ineligible Provider List* (S&I List) is updated monthly. For a complete S&I List, visit the Medi-Cal Web site at www.medi-cal.ca.gov and click the “S & I Provider List” link under “Provider Reference.” Providers may also order a hard copy update by calling the Telephone Service Center (TSC) at 1-800-541-5555.

Additions and changes are shown in bold type and reinstated providers are removed from the S&I List. Always refer to the S&I List when verifying provider ineligibility.

Eligibility or ineligibility must also be verified through the Health and Human Services (HHS) Office of Inspector General (OIG) *List of Excluded Individuals/Entities*, which can be accessed on the HHS Office of Inspector General Web site (www.oig.hhs.gov) by clicking “Exclusions Database.”

Suspension of Entities Submitting Claims for Suspended Providers

Entities submitting claims for services rendered by a health care provider suspended from Medi-Cal or excluded from Medicare or Medicaid by the Federal Office of Inspector General are subject to Medi-Cal suspension.

Welfare and Institutions Code (W&I Code), Section 14043.61(a), states, in relevant part, that “a provider shall be subject to suspension if claims for payment are submitted under any provider number used by the provider to obtain reimbursement from Medi-Cal for the services, goods, supplies or merchandise provided, directly or indirectly, to a Medi-Cal recipient by an individual or entity that is suspended, excluded, or otherwise ineligible because of a sanction to receive, directly or indirectly, reimbursement from Medi-Cal and the individual or entity is listed on either the *Medi-Cal Suspended and Ineligible Provider List* or any list published by the Federal Office of Inspector General regarding the suspension or exclusion of individuals or entities from the Federal Medicare and Medicaid programs, to identify suspended, excluded, or otherwise ineligible providers.”
